Answer: Surah Ar-Rahman
4. How many times is Prophet Muhammad Sallallahu alayhi wa Sallam mentioned by name in the Holy Qur’an?  
Answer: Four times
5. What did Prophet Nuh `Alayhissalam used to work as?

Answer: 17 raka’ahs
9. In which year after hijrah (migration), was fasting in Ramadan prescribed for Muslims?  
Answer: Second year after hijrah
10. Which noble wife of the Holy Prophet Sallallahu `alayhi wa Sallam was known as “Umm ul-Masakeen” (The Mother of the Poor) since she used to help the poor and needy?
